Center For Family Services has its greatest impact on communities when we focus on what we do best. In the year ahead, we will continue to expand our work, deepen our impact, and address the most pressing community needs and issues.

Vision Statement

The Vision of Center For Family Services is for all people to lead capable, responsible, fulfilled lives in strong families and healthy communities.

Mission Statement

The Mission of Center For Family Services is to support and empower individuals, families and communities to achieve a better life through vision, hope and strength.

What We Do

Center For Family Services offers a wide range of services dedicated to improving the lives of children, youth, and families. Each of our more than 53 programs is designed to ensure that people are able to reach their full potential at every stage of life, from birth to old age. Our service areas include:

- **Child, Adolescent, and Family Services** that help strengthen the capacity of young people and at risk families to navigate difficult times and make positive choices. Our staff teaches critical parenting skills, increased problem solving abilities, decrease high-risk behaviors, and offer counseling and support services. Our staff strengthened over 4111 children and families last year with these services.
- **Safe and Supportive Housing** that provides shelter, security, and support for children who are homeless, runaways, neglected or abused, moms who are homeless with their children, and women escaping domestic violence. Our continuum gives youth and adults the stable foundation they need to become self-sufficient through temporary shelters, residential treatment centers, transitional living apartments, and the development of permanent affordable housing. Our facilities were a safe, secure home for 427 young people last year alone.
- **Substance Abuse Treatment** that offers assessment, treatment, education, and support. This is available for adolescents, adults, and families, including a specialized program for mothers working to overcome their addictions and maintain or regain custody of their children, as well as the only program in the state that provides addiction recovery and case management services for the deaf – by the deaf. Over 3,560 people received treatment to overcome their addictions last year alone, and received over 24,000 hours of service.
- **Victim and Trauma Response** services that respond to people of all ages who have been the victim of trauma, sexual or domestic violence. Staff provides 24 hour live hotline response; counseling; accompaniments to hospitals, law enforcement and courts; advocacy and intervention. These services impact the lives of more than 2100 victims and their families.
- **Counseling, Community, and School Based Services** that work with vulnerable people to connect them to the resources they need through three statewide 24-hour hotlines. We provide individual, group, and family counseling, help low income seniors stay safely in their homes, and conduct child assault and bullying prevention programs in schools. Over 1100 people received counseling services, and more than 63,000 people were helped through hotline responses and assault prevention and bullying workshops.

Breaking the Cycle



Chiquita faced many challenges throughout her life. She became a single mother at the age of 16, and as she struggled with the responsibilities of motherhood, she found herself unable to finish her education. As a result, she found it challenging to maintain stable employment to provide for herself and her children. Chiquita found herself on the same difficult path as that of her own mother and others she knew.

Center For Family Services (CFS) has a long history of working with families like Chiquita's...families in crisis, parents unable to provide basic necessities for their children, and young moms starting a family without ever having had the role models or parenting supports they needed to succeed. Last year, CFS worked with the State of New Jersey to combine two important prevention and intervention programs in an effort to provide a more comprehensive service for low-income, at-risk moms like Chiquita.

Through this newly combined initiative, clients benefit from both a national model program, Healthy Families, and the TANF Initiative for Parents (TIP) program. By bringing these two programs together, families can get the help they need most, either in their homes, in the community, or both. This helps to ensure a mom can access the resources she needs to create a better life for herself and her children. For moms like Chiquita, it is often this service and support that changes their life.

When Chiquita became pregnant with her fourth child, she connected with Center For Family Services' Healthy Families -TANF Initiative For Parents (TIP)

program. “Before Center For Family Services, I did not understand what it meant to be a parent. The program gave me the guidance I needed and taught me how to provide and care for my children.”

The program connected Chiquita to community resources and information, giving her the ability to improve her life. Chiquita began to understand how to handle life and parenting responsibilities. She learned to budget, cook healthy meals, care for her home, write a resume, improve her literacy skills, and set appropriate limits for her own children. Chiquita enrolled in school and received her GED. After graduating from the Center’s Healthy Families-TIP program, Chiquita went back to school and received certification as a medical assistant. She is now working at Cooper Hospital as a critical care technician helping hospice patients. She

lives in a home she can call her own in Camden City and is able to provide for and care for her children.

Through the combined Healthy Families-TIP initiative that includes a combination of in home and in community supports, more moms can break the cycle of poverty, abuse, and neglect by achieving self-sufficiency.

“Because of Center For Family Services, I know I can achieve more for myself. I can be a better person, for myself, and for my family. The program is something young mothers need. Center For Family Services changed my direction in life. Because of CFS, I am now a strong, confident, hard working mom. I can care and provide for my family so they never have to face the obstacles I had to. Words cannot describe what they have done for me and my family.”

Changing Attitudes About a Silent Epidemic

“Now, thousands of women no longer consider themselves victims.”



For more than a decade, Center For Family Services has responded to the needs of victims of sexual violence. The Center started the Services Empowering the Rights of Victims (SERV) program in 1998 to respond to the alarming number of sexual assaults affecting people in our community. Sexual violence has profound lasting negative effects on the victim, those who know them, and the entire community.

To answer the call of suffering victims, Center For Family Services launched a 24-hour toll free hotline; offered accompaniments to hospital emergency rooms, courts and police stations; provided counseling and support programs; and created outreach and education programs for the community in elementary schools, high schools, and at colleges throughout the region.

The SERV program is now the designated rape crisis center for Camden, Gloucester, and Cumberland Counties. CFS staff are an integral part of a committed team working closely with hospitals, law enforcement, and prosecutors to help victims get the help they need in a non-threatening and non-judgmental way. Now, thousands of women no longer consider themselves victims. *Because of Center For Family Services, they are now survivors.*

While we knew that the services provided helped victims to heal from their trauma, and our outreach offered victims a safe place to turn, it was clear that it was time to do more. It was time to take the next step.

The Center For Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) now considers sexual violence a “public health problem of epidemic proportions” that affects everyone, directly or indirectly, and results in long-term social and economic costs. In 2008, New Jersey was one of six states in the US to be selected to implement the primary prevention of sexual violence project. Center For Family Services was selected to build a major prevention initiative for three New Jersey Counties.

The goal of this project is to prevent sexual violence before it occurs. To accomplish this critical task, the Center has created a Prevention Coalition comprised of community members, school and government administrators, students, faith based organizations, health care and law enforcement professionals and survivors.

CFS remains strongly committed to responding to victims in crisis, counseling victims so that they can become survivors, and educating children, teens,



and adults about how to avoid harmful situations. But, the staff now serve as leaders and conveners in an important effort to change the environment that contributes to sexual violence, to change attitudes and behaviors before they can lead to victimization, and to educate people of all ages, genders, and cultures on how they can play a role in stopping sexual violence before it ever starts.

A Treatment Program With Staying Power

In 1989, we recognized a need for recovery treatment services for the deaf community after receiving a call from a grandmother concerned about the lack of services for her deaf grandson who was battling addiction. In an effort to respond, substance abuse staff began offering treatment through interpreted services. But, realizing that communication barriers and trust issues still existed, Center For Family Services launched the Deaf Recovery Network Program, the first substance abuse treatment service for the deaf by the deaf.

In 1992, the Deaf Recovery Network became a direct treatment service provider, hiring a deaf counselor and gaining the reputation among the deaf community as a treatment program with staying power. In 1995, Deaf Recovery Network became one of the only treatment programs for deaf clients with a translated 12-step program re-written in American Sign Language for the benefit of clients. And, with the realization that the breadth of hearing loss encompassed more than just deaf people, the program was renamed "Recovery Network for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing."

Since then, The Center's Recovery Network for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Program has been recognized as an outstanding treatment program with the power to provoke positive change in individuals and families. We have worked tirelessly to expand the services available for deaf people throughout New Jersey who are struggling to overcome their addictions.

For the deaf and hard of hearing client, lack of necessary communication assistance intensifies the barriers and obstacles that already face those needing treatment. To break down these barriers, Center For Family Services was able to expand the Recovery Network

Program to provide communication access services. The Center's Recovery Network Program now coordinates a statewide communication access initiative that provides for interpreter services for the deaf wherever they receive treatment. This access component includes sign language, oral and tactile interpreters, various assistive listening devices, and more.

An additional case management component also enables the Center to provide continued recovery support to deaf and hard of hearing clients who are building and sustaining a new substance free life style. With the recent commitment of the Center to focus efforts on the housing needs of CFS clients, the Recovery Network is partnering very closely with our Housing Development Department to place our first recovering deaf tenant into a supported apartment.

Now, more than 20 years later, we remain a treatment program with staying power. The Center's Recovery Network Program remains the only substance abuse program in New Jersey dedicated to providing services for the deaf community.



Making a Difference...Together

Many of the children and families that come to us are struggling with poverty, homelessness, and dangerous living situations. Some have nothing but the clothes they are wearing and no family at all to care for them. At Center For Family Services, we strive to do more than just provide services...we help people envision a better life for themselves; we work with them to achieve their individual goals; we provide them with the tools needed for success.

- We know that an education is critical to success. But, without school clothes, backpacks, or even a pencil, kids living in poverty lose focus on their studies.
- Experiencing some of the joy of the holidays and opening presents on Christmas morning is a part of life most kids take for granted. But, for the kids living in our shelters and group homes, the holidays are often the most difficult time of the year, and they can feel like they have nothing to live for or work toward.
- For families forced to make difficult choices between providing clothes or food and heat for their children, many babies and children go without pajamas in the winter and do not have the resources at home to encourage their learning.

- For teens who have never had the benefit of strong families or positive role models, survival has too often been their top priority, and they now lack social and life skills.

But, with support from the community, we are able to provide the many little things that have huge impact. Over the last year, individuals, businesses, and organizations throughout South Jersey stepped up to give children and families hope for a better tomorrow. By participating in the annual Operation Backpack Drive, the Holiday Gift Project, the National Pajama Program, and through contributions to support program activities, you made a difference and changed a life.

The backpack that helps a kid fit in and gives him the confidence to stay in school...the gift that a teen living in the shelter finds under the tree when they expected nothing because they have no one...the relief a desperate teen mom feels because she is now able to snuggle her baby into warm pajamas in the middle of winter...the first time a teenager goes to a restaurant and orders something from a menu – these are the life changing experiences that are possible because of your support.

Our success in changing the lives of children and families is the result of the community as a whole working

together to make a difference. Over the last year, donors, volunteers, and CFS staff have:

- Organized fundraising efforts in your local community, businesses, or churches
- Partnered with the Greater Camden Partnership to “Clean and Green” Camden City neighborhoods,
- Provided new backpacks, school supplies, clothing, and holiday gifts to disadvantaged youth and families
- Mentored at-risk youth in Camden City
- Coordinated landscaping projects that made our community a nicer place to live
- Provided ready made meals to struggling families
- Served as volunteer advocates for victims of violence
- Taught art and music to teens in our shelters and group homes
- Offered budgeting classes so that our clients are better equipped to live independently
- Sponsored and participated in our annual fundraising events

We can not do it alone. Together, we can change the world...one child, one family at a time.

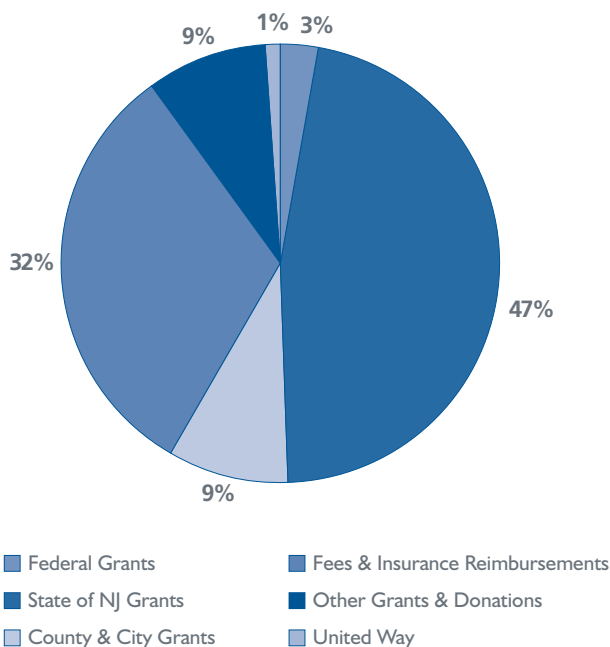

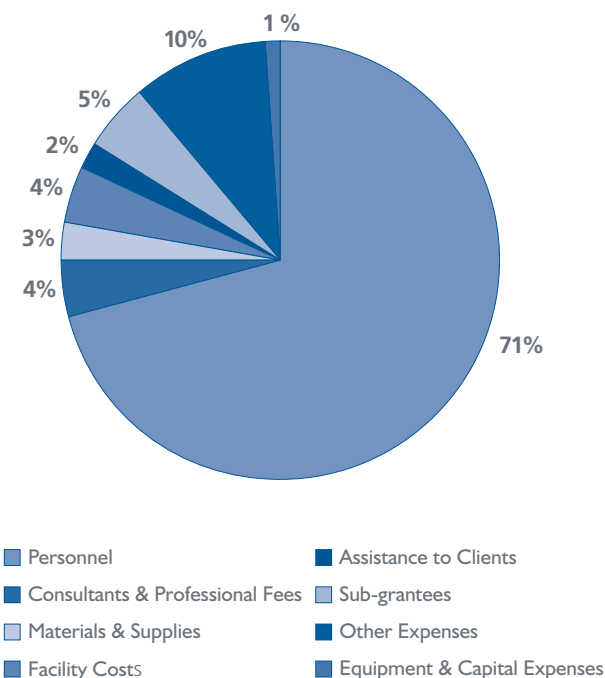
